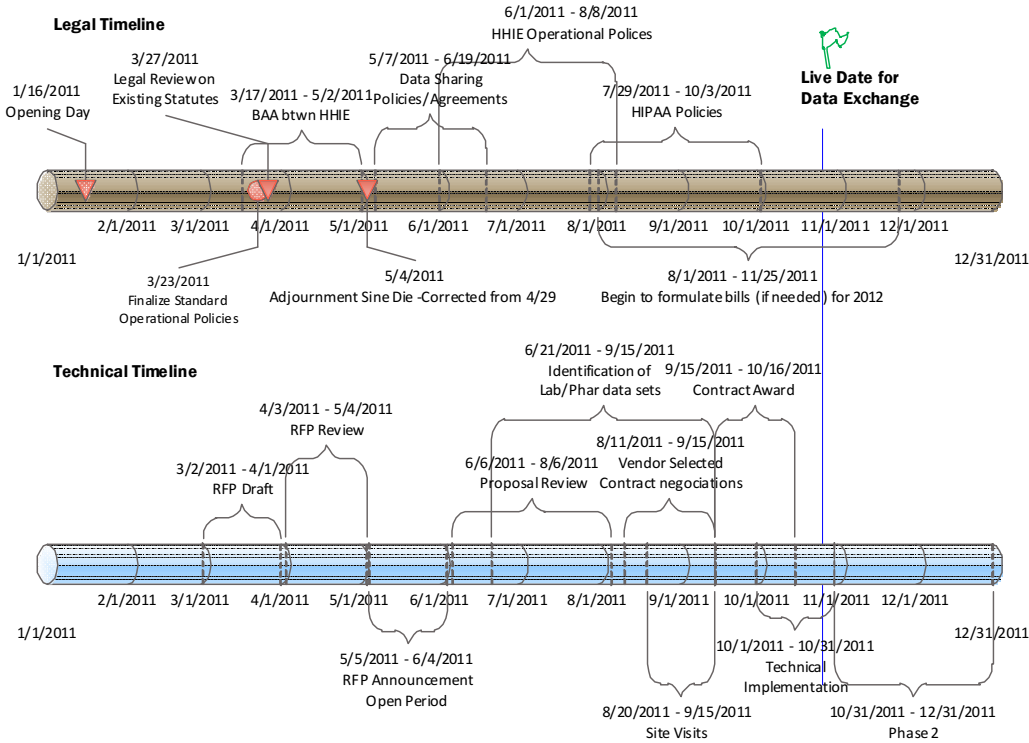

Bill	Measure Title	Report Title	Description
SB420	Relating to Health	DHS, FQHC additional funding MU office	Appropriates funds to DOH to expand certain health care services, Eligible Service Providers, FQHCs, and promotes office to certify MU and certify eligibility of providers.
SB978	Related to Medicaid	DHS IT for Medicaid Eligibility	Appropriates funds for implementing a new information technology system for determining medicaid eligibility. \$4,000,000 allocated.
SB1401	Appropriating for HIT	Appropriation for HIT; Federal matching grants	Appropriate funds to DOH to participate in any federal matching grant programs with respect to HIT systems.
SB797	Appropriation for health information technology	Appropriation; Health Information Technology; Federal Matching Grants	Appropriate funds to DOH to participate in any federal matching grant programs authorized by HITECH with respect to HIT systems. (Similar to SB1401)
SB1287	Relating to information technology	Information Technology; Chief Information Officer; Shared Services Technology Special Fund; Appropriation	Authorizes the appointment of a chief information officer and for the office to employ persons not subject to chapters 76, 78, and 89, Hawaii Revised Statutes; transfers the shared services technology special fund from the department of budget and finance to the department of accounting and general services, specifies a percentage from special funds for deposit into the fund, and establishes a trust account in the fund; authorizes the chief information officer and comptroller to raise funds and accept donations for the fund; requires the chief information officer to submit annual reports; appropriates funds. SB1348	Relating to the Hawai'i Health Insurance Exchange	Hawaii Health Insurance Exchange	Establishes the Hawaii Health Connector to create a health insurance exchange pursuant to the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010; creates Hawaii health insurance exchange council under a board of directors; creates board of directors; creates task force to recommend policies and procedures to implement the governance of the health insurance exchange. (SD1) (\$)
